Thank you for your inquiry to the Massachusetts Historical Commission, received October 10, 2006 for the project referenced above. Staff of the MHC have reviewed our files and the information you submitted. The proposed project consists of the creation of a stormwater management pollution prevention plan for Ranor, Inc. in Westminster.
